Planting Procedure

We know that adding a new tree to your property is a big investment. That is why we want to set you up for success!



- The first step is to schedule a free consultation on your property with an arborist. We will look at your space and give you our recommendations for the space you have and what to look for in a tree.
- Next, we want you to choose the tree you love! We have a list of recommended local nurseries in this packet to purchase your tree. Some of which offer a 1-year warranty.
- After your tree is purchased, we will take over from there! We will place a dig-rite ticket for your property to locate any underground utilities, pick up the tree from the nursery and deliver it on planting day. The tree will be planted by an Arborist to ANSI standards with a mulch ring. We will leave you with care instructions for your new tree.
- The last step is to relax knowing the hard work is done by professionals and enjoy your new planting!

Pricing for planting jobs is based on size and type of nursery stock selected.

Container Trees

5-7 gallon and/or under 10' \$200

10-15 gallon and/or 10-15' tall **\$250**

20-30 gallon and/or 15-20' tall

\$325

Balled & Burlapped Trees

Under 1" caliper and/or under \$250

1-1.5" caliper and/or 10-15' \$325

1.75-2" caliper and/or 15-20' \$425

Recommended Tree List

We have compiled a list of trees that we have found do well in our area.

We recommend starting with smaller, container trees. These tend to have more of a root system and establish quicker than larger trees or balled and burlapped trees that don't have much of a root system to begin with.

When selecting a tree from a nursery, look for one that is free from damage on the and has one central stem for the best structure.
